We all want to wish you a very happy Thanksgiving and hope to see you soon!





## **Custom Lumber Dimensions: Have it Your Way!**

We will mill any dimension you want from our logs, your logs or lumber you bring to us. This can be very useful when you are repairing or remodeling and you need to match an older piece of lumber. For example, there are many homes in the San Luis Obispo County that were framed with 'full dimensional' 2x4s, that is, a full 2" x 4". Today's building material for a standard 2x4 is actually 1 1/2" x 3 1/2". This is referred to in the industry as 'nominal dimension'. Another example of 'progress' (yes, sarcasm!) is that most commodity lumber yards carry fence boards that in the past would have been 1" thick are now just 9/16" thick! The fact of the matter is that a full dimensional fence board can last decades longer than these thinner boards being sold today.

We have had many orders for full dimensional fence boards and the resounding sentiment is "This is the LAST time I am going to have to rebuild this fence!"

So, whatever your need is, we can custom mill to satisfy your goal. Call anytime
